Max. limb diameter: 6" Max. pile size: 4'x4'x20' No trash, lumber, leaves, bagged materials of any kind. Piles must be on roadside, not driveways. Do not block hydrants or roads. Avoid making piles more than 2 weeks prior to your Chipper Day.

GRANTS AVAILABLE

The **Marin Wildfire Prevention Authority** has residential grants available to reimburse up to \$1,000 in qualifying defensible space expenses and up to \$500 in home hardening expenses.

****A Defensible Space and Home Hardening Evaluation report is required.****

FIRE SAFE CHECKLIST

- Familiarize yourself with the Marin County **Emergency Portal:**
emergency.marincounty.org
- Register your mobile phone with Alert Marin to receive emergency alerts:
marinsheriff.org/services/emergency-services/alert-marin
- Visit firesafemarin.org and update your evacuation plan & “go-kit.”
- Get to know your Disaster Council Area Coordinator. Call the fire station for more info.
- Get a NOAA Emergency Alert Weather Radio to stay informed in case of a disaster. Available for \$20 at the Fire Station.
- Pick up free Evacuation Tags at the fire station, to display on your home after you leave under an evacuation order.
- Know your *Community Refuge Areas* (CRAs): Mesa Park, the Bolinas School, and the beaches
- If you or someone you know has mobility issues, consider adding them to the Bolinas Fire Department’s *At-Risk List*
- Practice fire safety, and maintain awareness on Red Flag days
